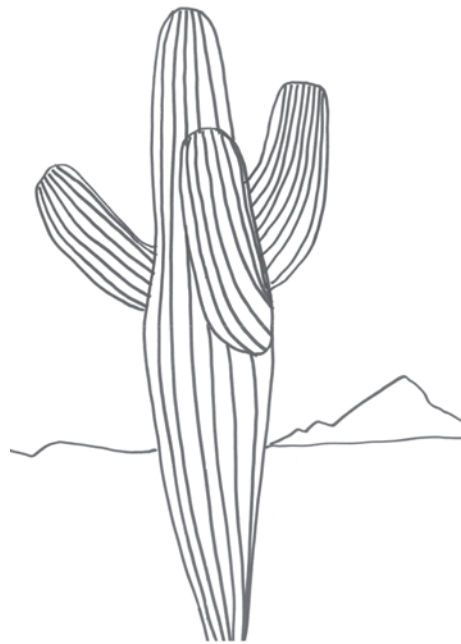

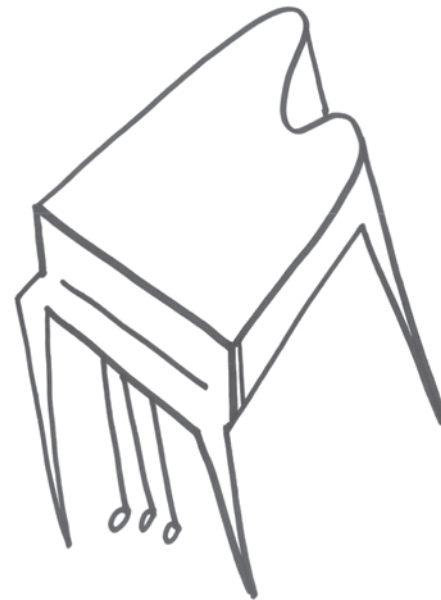

Summer is an exciting season as many of our classes transition from a 6-week session to a 1-week mini-camp. You can feel the excitement in the air as young and old alike are transported to the days of summer, a time where taking a class is not for a passing grade, but for the experience and joy of learning. This year I am seeing a trend in our classes, a trend that is happening in education and even the broader corporate world, the concept of the adult camp. We have had several instructors, independent of one another, propose **mini-camps for adults**, classes that we are offering alongside our full complement of youth mini-camps. Also new this season are two, arts focused, **all-day summer camps for two weeks in August** (page 7).

We are adding some **summer fun into our gallery schedule** as well. We will have two group exhibitions, the much-anticipated format of pop-up shows in June and our annual instructor show (*august August*) in (you guessed it!) August. Barbetta Lockart (July) and Chris Shackel (September) will each have solo exhibitions.



During the Winter/Spring season, our **staff participated in a range of classes** both as students and instructors. Staff members took *Charcoal Drawing; Geometric Drawing, Tessellations, Honeycombs and M. C. Escher; Book Art: Bound by Hand and Traveling Artist*. Staff members taught *Botanical Drawing; Mess Free, Stress Free Valentines and Electronic Sound, Synthesis and Music*. The fun we had both learning and teaching has given us fresh ideas for planning programs, classes and helping you experience the Arts Center in a new way.

Lastly, I would like to invite you to a community wide project – *The Natural History Guide to Davis – 100 Items for 100 Years*. Please plan to join us on an exploration of our City’s natural history through workshops, some presented by guest instructors, which will focus on strengthening your artistic skillset. Imagine Charlie Harper and John Muir Laws.

Artwork of any of the 100 items produced between now and December 31 may be submitted for inclusion in *The Natural History Guide to Davis – 100 Items for 100 Years* book. The book will be published next year, just in time to celebrate the centennial of the City of Davis. Details of the project forthcoming - stay tuned!

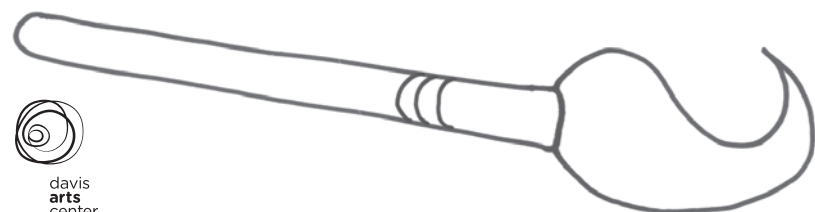

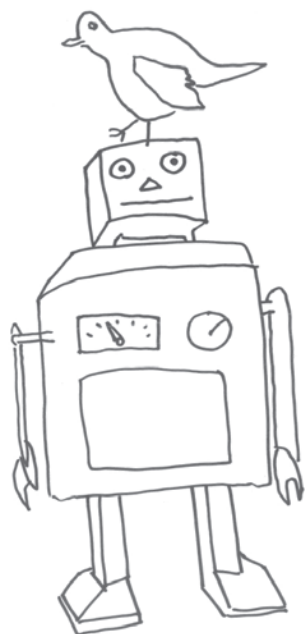

Registration Procedures

You may register for Davis Arts Center classes in the following ways:

4. Fax the completed registration form with credit card information to (530) 756-3041.
5. Call (530) 756-4100 to register by telephone. We accept most credit cards, including Discover, MasterCard, Visa and American Express.

All registrations are considered confirmed when payment is received. You will not receive further confirmation. Therefore, it is your responsibility to record all personal registration information to ensure attendance on the correct date and time. You will be notified by phone or by email if a class for which you have registered is postponed or cancelled.

REGISTRATION POLICIES

Late Fees

Davis Arts Center fees are due in full at the time of registration. Students may not participate unless all fees have been paid. Instructors cannot be paid if fees are outstanding, so please be courteous to your instructor and to Arts Center staff by paying for classes at the start of each session. **A \$5 administration fee will be charged for each class registration received more than 7 days after the first day of the class.**

Cancellations

We urge you to register at least 1 week before the beginning of a class session, since minimum enrollment must be met for classes to be held. When enrollment is below the minimum 5 days prior to the first day of class, there is a strong possibility that the class will be cancelled. We will make every effort to contact registered students in a timely manner if cancellation occurs. If a class is cancelled by the instructor registrants will receive a full refund.

Wait Lists

Once an instructor's maximum enrollment is reached, names will be placed on a wait list and students will be notified if an opening occurs. Contact the Davis Arts Center office to be added to a wait list.

Please note: Scholarships can be given to the same family only once per year.

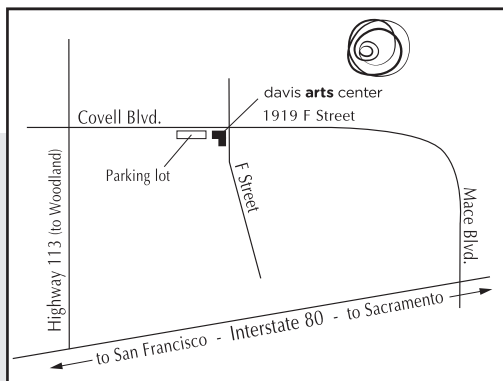
Interpreter Services

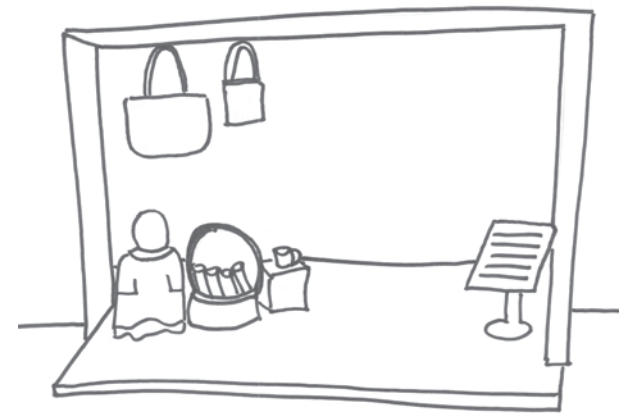
